INTERNSHIP AND MISSIONS		
Description of activities	This internship is part of an on-going collaboration between Faces of Cancer Saint Lucia and the Vaughan Arthur Lewis Institute for research and Innovation (VALIRI, Saint Lucia). The candidate will collect data retrospectively from health participants from registration forms and will perform statistical analyses on that data. The candidate will also participate in all on-going scientific projects on this topic.	
Objectives of the internship	Produce new knowledge on the profile of health fair participants and their cancer screening habits to better improve the offering of services at the health fairs and understand the role of health fairs in Cancer control within the context of Saint Lucia as an under-resourced island state.	
Missions	 Entering the data from health fair registration forms from 2012 to 2022. Participate in the process for ethics approval. Participation in the conception and submission of a new research proposal Preliminary analysis of the data set (frequency tables, statistical tests). Participate in the production scientific manuscript for publication in a peer-reviewed journal
